USSSA MEMBERSHIP

All athletes and coaches must be a member of their USSSA Association or sign up for the USSSA membership at the door.

COMPETITION RULES

USSSA Taekwondo rules apply to all competition conducted at the USSSA National **Qualifier**. All coaches and officials at the 2009 USSSA Nationals must have completed at least one certification and also have officiated or coached at one State or Regional qualifier. USSSA Taekwondo Rules may be downloaded directly off the USSSA website at www.usssa.com. We strongly encourage all instructors review this website so that all competitors are familiar with the rules.

This is a Regional Qualifier to the USSSA Nationals will be held in Branson, Missouri. Qualification may only be determined through: (A) USSSA State Championships, and (B) USSSA Regional Sanctioned Qualifiers.

USSSA State Championships, USSSA Regional Sanctioned Qualifiers and special Sanctioned Qualifiers:

These events may qualify the top eight (8) athletes from each appropriate age and division category to participate in the USSSA Nationals.

AWARDS

Specially designed and crafted **USSSA MEDALS** will be awarded to the top four (4) Places in each division.

Team Points:

First, second and third place will be awarded points for their school and the schools with the highest totals will be awarded trophies. All results will be recorded, with three points being given for each gold medal, two points given for each silver medal, and one point for each bronze medal.

National Points:

National points will be awarded to those who place first, second and third. Nationals points will also be awarded to each participating athlete. These can be viewed along with your national rating within 14 days of this event at www.usssa.com.

UNIFORMS & EQUIPMENT

Uniforms:

All competitors can wear their school uniforms and patches, which are allowed at all State and Regional Qualifiers. (White must be worn at Nationals).

Mandatory Equipment:

Point Sparring – All competitors must wear full hand and foot protections (any color foam dipped/vinyl only), head gear (any color dipped foam only), chest gear and mouth guard. Male competitors must also wear groin cup and supporters for all sparring.
Olympic Sparring – All competitors must wear an Olympic style chest protector, headgear, (any color), shin & instep protectors, and forearm protectors and mouth guards. Males are required to wear a protective cup.

Optional Equipment:

Competitors may wear cloth or foam shin and forearm protectors (any color only) at their discretion in point sparring.

SPECIAL NOTES

The tournament committee reserves the right to further divide or combine divisions depending on the number of competitors registered to compete in each.
